### STATEMENT

I have always loved jewelry since I was a young girl. My first attempts to make jewelry when eight or nine consisted of finding unusually shaped stones from the shores of Lake Michigan, using adhesive tape to fasten a safety pin on the back, and gluing on yarn, beads, etc. It wasn't until my senior year in college that I had professional instruction on how to make jewelry! I owe everything I know about that to my wonderful professor, Mary Tingley. She was an instructor par excellence. The best of all my art instructors at UW-Milwaukee. I got so excited about making jewelry that I went on to graduate school to make it one of my majors, the other being painting. I received my Master of Science of Art in 1968.

I should also mention John Murphy, an art professor from Parkside with whom I did post-graduate work as an Independent Study student while I was teaching art. He was very inspirational.

My work has some classical pieces, but is mostly non-traditional, even rather avant-garde, I love to incorporate found objects into my work. None of it is for sale as I make it for myself to wear or to show in galleries.
